- Possess an attitude of servant leadership.
- Model the call, character and competencies becoming a minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Committed to moral purity and a healthy relationship with his spouse and family.
- Must be or become a member of WBC and sign a "Ministry Leaders Registration Form" which includes having a Background Check and indicating agreement with the WBC Doctrine Statement and the WBC Outside Employment Policy.

Job Qualifications

- Previous experience in the areas of worship
- BA or BS degree, (MA or MDIV preferred) OR working towards a degree in ministry.
- Needs to live within the local community.

Responsibilities

- Demonstrate an obvious passion and heart for leading the congregation in worship.
- Lead worship by example in such a way to promote authentic worship and unity within the congregation.
- Plan, Lead, and Coordinate each WBC worship service under the direction of the Senior Pastor who is the "Director" in terms of setting the theme and overall direction of the worship service.

- In harmony with the leadership of the Senior Pastor, draw the church body into worshipping God through carefully chosen music and lyrics and by helping them understand and become involved in corporate worship.
- Lead worship using a variety of styles including hymns, gospel songs, and contemporary Christian music.
- Sensitive to the style of music that best fits the needs of the congregation. Use music creatively to lift up, challenge and comfort the church while glorifying God.
- Interact in an ongoing way with the congregation as they give input to worship styles and preferences.
- Engage a variety of artistic expressions to celebrate the Biblical communication and experience of worship across the WBC Family.
- Utilize technology and visually engaging elements and oversee its tasteful and Biblical use.
- Support the growth of worship in other ministries of the church.
- Lead the Worship Team in discipling, developing, and presenting the framework for worship in all services and other events as needed.
- Oversee and coordinate all necessary rehearsals.
- Develop and encourage rising musicians and singers to know the joy of leading others in worship and giving opportunities for them to share their gifts and talents in the worship life of WBC.
- Recruit new vocalists and instrumentalists on an ongoing basis. Plan and lead required classes for worship arts participation.
- Oversee the livestreaming recording of WBC Worship Services and the technical aspects of the service with the tech team to provide a high-quality experience for those who access the WBC online ministry.
- Oversee the sound system and the team are giving the desired balance and sound desired for the church services.
- Attend weekly staff meetings and engage in brainstorming planning sessions across church ministries.
- Develop and administer the annual budget for the worship ministry.
- Oversee the management of music licensing and other subscriptions and programs in the worship ministry.
